- B. **ACCESS:** PROVIDE ACCESS TO A DIVERSE POPULATION, INCLUDING UNDER REPRESENTED GROUPS, THROUGH A VARIETY OF METHODS INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, INNOVATIVE RECRUITING AND RETENTION STRATEGIES, MULTIPLE LOCATIONS, VARIED DELIVERY METHODS, NEW PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT AND RESOURCEFUL APPLICATIONS OF TECHNOLOGY.
  
- C. **QUALITY:** DELIVER HIGH-QUALITY EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND SERVICES THAT PROVIDE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES NEEDED TO EXPERIENCE PROSPEROUS AND REWARDING LIVES IN AN INCREASINGLY DIVERSE AND GLOBAL SOCIETY AND THAT EMPHAIZE THE DEVELOPMENT OF MULTI-CULTURAL AWARENESS AND SENSITIVITIES THAT PROMOTE PERSONAL AND CAREER SUCCESS.
  
- D. **RESOURCEFULNESS:** ENSURE ACADEMIC PROGRAM EFFECTIVENESS AND FINANCIAL ACCOUNTABILITY BY MAXIMIZING THE USE OF AVAILABLE RESOURCES THROUGH SHARING, LEVERAGING TECHNOLOGY, RENOVATING EXISTING SPACE, AND INCREASING SUPPORT FROM EXTERNAL SOURCES.
  
- E. **TEACHING AND LEARNING:** PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES AND PROMOTE THE USE OF TECHNOLOGY TO ENHANCE THE TEACHING AND LEARNING PROCESS IN ORDER TO RESPOND TO THE EDUCATIONAL NEEDS OF STUDENTS AND THE COMMUNITY.
