Check your Chattanooga State email and Tigerweb account at a minimum once a week for important announcements concerning financial aid and other campus information.

A completed file consists of **all required documents turned into the Enrollment Services by the date indicated on the chart.** Financial aid students can use pending aid to pay their fees. To pay fees follow the steps to confirm on the ChSCC's Financial Aid webpage.

Once a student receives their excess financial aid check, the student is responsible for any balances on their account due to adding or dropping classes.

Think before cashing: Remaining in all your classes is critical to avoid repayment of federal and state funds. Also meeting the institutions Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) standard is required. If you are considering withdrawing from all your classes or dropping a class, you should first read the policy on keeping your aid at www.chattanoogastate.edu/financialaid/fakeep.html or seek guidance from a financial aid representative.

All awards on your TigerWeb account represent the amount you would be eligible for if you attend full-time. The chart below will assist you in determining the amount of federal and state aid you will receive if you enroll in less than a full-time status.

Enrollment Status	Amount of aid listed on your account you will receive	
Full-time	12 or more hours	100%
¾ Time	9 – 11 hour	75%
½ Time	6 – 8 hours	50%
Less than ½ Time	less than 6 hours	to be determined (not eligible for federal Stafford loans or some scholarships)
