Nursing Course Points (Max 13pts)	General education & support courses that have been completed by the end of the Fall semester prior to the application deadline. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Biology courses receive more weight than other general education courses •A grade of "C" or better required for all nursing curriculum courses •A&P I, A&P II and Microbiology must have been completed within the past 5 years.
Nursing GPA (Max 40 pts)	A grade point average (GPA) is calculated based on the completion of general education and support courses in the nursing curriculum. **A nursing GPA of 2.5 or greater is required for inclusion in the applicant pool**
TEAS Test (Max 50 pts)	All applicants must have the results of a current TEAS test on file. The test must have been taken within 2 years of the application deadline. Points awarded based on the average of the reading and math scores.
College GPA	Though not included in the points calculation, it is expected that a student will have at least a 2.0 overall college GPA to be included in the applicant pool and when entering their first nursing course.

3. TEAS TEST

- Average Adjusted Individual Reading & Adjusted Individual Math to get the composite score ($84 + 83 = 167$ followed by $167 \div 2 = 83.5$)
- Composite Score 83.5
- To get total points for this section divide composite by 2
- $83.5 \div 2 = 41.75$

- **College GPA of 2.0 or greater
