Close Contact with COVID-19 Confirmed Positive Case



According to the TN Dept of Health (www.tn.gov/health) and the CDC (www.cdc.gov): the identity of the individual must be kept confidential to the greatest extent possible.

Have you been in close contact* with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19?

*Per the Hamilton County Health Department, close contact is defined as being within six (6) feet of an individual for a period of 15 minutes or longer, and regardless of whether masks were being worn. Close contact does not mean walking by or briefly being in the same room.

FULLY VACCINATED

- 1. You should properly wear a well-fitting face mask when you are around other people for 10 days following the initial exposure.
- 2. You should monitor symptoms for at least 5 days following exposure.
- 3. You should consider getting a COVID-19 test 5 days following exposure, even if you are asymptomatic.

UNVACCINATED

- Fill out the COVID-19 Self-Reporting Form on TigerWeb at <u>tigerweb.chattanoogastate.edu/form/covid-self-reporting</u>.
- 2. You should immediately quarantine at home for no fewer than 5 days followed immediately by properly wearing a well-fitting face mask when you are around other people for another 5 days following the initial exposure.
- 3. If a 5 day quarantine is not feasible, you should properly wear a well-fitting face mask when you are around other people for 10 days following the initial exposure.
- 4. You should monitor symptoms for at least 5 days following exposure.
- 5. You should consider getting a COVID-19 test 5 days following exposure even if you are asymptomatic.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- You should monitor yourself closely for symptoms of COVID-19 and seek medical advice immediately should symptoms occur.
- · Notify anyone with whom you have been in close contact since your potential exposure.
- You may not return to campus until the conclusion of the 5-day quarantine period and only if you are not showing symptoms
 of COVID-19. This applies even if you are tested for COVID-19 during quarantine and the results are negative as you may be
 asymptomatic and still be infectious.
