Preparation and Registration

The ACCUPLACER® Next-Generation tests are untimed computer-adaptive assessments used for initial placement or as placement challenge tests. You may take each subject test only **two times**, so we recommend that you prepare before testing. Use these websites to get an idea what to expect when you test:

Table 1: This table provides the minimum score requirements on Accuplacer tests for differing academic programs.

Credit students: Use EdReady **English Test 1** and **English Test 2** for help with **ACCUPLACER Reading** and/or **ACCUPLACER Writing** skills. Use EdReady **Math Test 1** and **Math Test 2** for help with **ACCUPLACER Quantitative Reasoning** skills.

TCAT students: Use EdReady **TCAT Reading** for help with **ACCUPLACER Reading** skills. Use EdReady **TCAT Math** for help with **ACCUPLACER Arithmetic** skills.

TCAT medical students: Use EdReady **English Test 1** and **English Test 2** for help with **ACCUPLACER Reading** skills. Use EdReady **TCAT Math** for help with **ACCUPLACER Arithmetic** skills.

TCAT LPN students: Use EdReady **English Test 1** and **English Test 2** for help with **ACCUPLACER Reading** skills. Use EdReady **Math Test 1** and **Math Test 2** for help with **ACCUPLACER Quantitative Reasoning** skills.

Line 1: Select "Placement" from the dropdown menu.

Line 2: Select the appropriate test(s):

Credit (degree or certificate program) students: Select **Placement – Writing/Reading/Math** for **all** tests **or** choose individual tests if you need only one or two tests. **DO NOT** choose TCAT tests.

TCAT students (all TCAT programs except LPN): Select **Placement - TCAT Reading and Math** for both tests. Choose TCAT Math **or** TCAT Reading if you need to test or retest on one subject only.

LPN students: Select **Placement – Reading and Math**. This will register you for the Reading test and the Quantitative Math test required for the LPN program.

Lines 3 and 4: Select your preferred date and time for testing.

Complete the remaining lines with your personal information and submit.

IMPORTANT: You must know your correct A# when you report to take the tests!
