

# Digital Media Design & Production: Graphic Design Concentration

# **Associate of Applied Science Degree**

#### **Program Overview:**

The Graphic Design concentration focuses on print media. Students are prepared for careers in graphic design firms and advertising agencies, printing and graphic arts service industries and in-plant or in-house art departments. Students will need to spend approximately \$250-\$300 for basic professional equipment the first semester and \$100-\$150 per semester for consumable supplies.

## What Will I Do On The Job?

Graphic designers work with type and images to create the look for communication materials, signage, CD/DVD inserts, books, magazines, posters, catalogs, electronic graphics and other products. Some also design websites. Almost all are expected to have a basic knowledge of web tools (HTML & CSS)

## What Skills Will I Use On The Job?

You will utilize organizational, creative and computer skills. As a graphic designer you will apply design theory and art skills while using current versions of page layout and editing software. Flexibility and willingness to take direction are also key.

## **Possible Job Titles:**

Graphic Designer, Graphic Services Specialist, Art Director, Pre-Press Technician, Printing, Graphic Service Sales Rep, Illustrator.

## Who Will Hire Me?

Many corporate businesses have marketing and advertising departments which have full-time positions for graphic designers. Advertising, design and marketing studios hire entry-level graphic designers. Other job opportunities can be found in the printing industry, non-profit organizations and freelance work. Chattanooga State graduates work with such organizations as: Marketing Alliance, Color Creek, National Print, IKON, Goldbond, Lodge Manufacturing.
