All Tennessee high school seniors can apply for the Tennessee Promise scholarship, which will provide for two years tuition-free at Chattanooga State (including the Tennessee College of Applied Technology), or at any community college in Tennessee. Tennessee Promise is a last-dollar scholarship, meaning it will cover tuition and mandatory fees not already covered by Pell grant, HOPE scholarship, and Tennessee Student Assistance Award.



TENNESSEE Reconnect

There has never been a better time for adults in Tennessee to complete a certificate or degree: with Tennessee Reconnect, you can earn a two-year degree tuition-free. Even if you are currently satisfied with your career, a degree can open up new doors for promotion and increase your earning potential.

In addition to free tuition, adult learners are provided a variety of services that includes advising and career counseling. College credit may be available for prior experience and training (PLA), including professional certifications, military service, apprenticeships, etc.

You are never too old to go back to school! One out of four undergraduate college students at our Tennessee public institutions are adult learners! You are not alone and we will make sure you connect with a support system of peer adult learners.

To be eligible for the Tennessee Reconnect scholarship, you must:

- not already have an associate or bachelor's degree.
- have been a Tennessee resident for at least one year.
- be determined as an independent student on the FAFSA.
